Canadian Admissions Policy for AY 2022-2023

To be considered for admission you must:

1. Complete the [online application](#).
2. Request that official secondary school academic records and final examination results be submitted on your behalf electronically to sholz@northland.edu or by mail. They must be signed, show the school's name and seal, and be in color, English, and (if electronic) PDF format.
3. If you have taken any college/university level classes, upload or email unofficial transcripts from all institutions attended. They must be in color, English, and PDF format.
4. **Only students with university transcripts** must supply an approved course-by-course evaluation of their academic records. Completed evaluations must be sent to Northland by the evaluation service directly to sholz@northland.edu.
 - a. Students may select any [NACES approved](#) credit evaluation service, but Northland recommends using one of the following:

International Education Evaluations, Inc.	Course-by-course Cost = \$145	5 business day processing
SpanTran	Course-by-course with GPA Cost = \$150	10 business days processing
World Education Services, Inc.	Basic course-by-course Cost = \$160	7 business days processing

5. You must provide standardized test results **UNLESS you meet one of the following**:
 - a. If your university transcript shows both courses of College Writing 1 and 2 with a grade of B or better (US grading scale).
 - b. If you have not taken both College Writing 1 and 2, but your secondary school transcript shows at least three years of English with a grade of B or better (US grading scale).

If your secondary transcript only has two years of English grades and you did not take College Writing 1 or 2, you can **choose one** of the following options:

- Email sholz@northland.edu your unofficial, lower secondary academic records to show your US Grade 9-equivalent English class. If you have a minimum of Bs in English for both your total upper secondary and final lower secondary classes (US grading scale), you are exempt from the standardized test results.
- Take any of the accepted standardized exams. See below for information and cost:
 - TOEFL Minimum score required: 69—Fees vary by country. [Learn more here.](#)
 - TOEFL Essentials Minimum score required: 7.5—Fees vary, approximately US\$100-\$120. [Learn more here.](#)
 - IELTS Minimum score required: 6.0—Fees vary by country. [Learn more here.](#)
 - GTEC Minimum score required: 1119—Primarily for students from Japan. [Learn more here.](#)
 - PTE Academic Minimum score required: 55—Fees vary by country. [Learn more here.](#)
 - *Duolingo English Test Minimum score required: 105—The cost is US\$49. [Learn more here.](#)
 - ACT Minimum composite score: 18; Minimum English sub-score: 18—Full ACT (*no writing*) US \$169.50, Full ACT (*with writing*) US \$188.50 [Learn more here.](#)
 - SAT Minimum composite score: 960; Minimum EBRW sub-score: 480—Fees vary by country and region. [Learn more here.](#)
