Jennings has also been recognized for his contributions to the community, receiving the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development's "40 under 40" Award and the University of Wisconsin-Madison Nelson Institute's Rising Star Alumni Award.

As a member of the Natural Resources Board, Jennings will oversee policies pertaining to the environment, from managing the state's wolf population to regulating "forever chemicals," or PFAS, in the state's water supply. He will be a strong voice for environmental protection and will work to prioritize the state's water quality.
