

INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY POLICY

All international applicants must demonstrate English proficiency to qualify for admission. This proficiency can be demonstrated in a number of ways. Please see options below:

Northland College reserves the right to request additional proof of English proficiency from all applicants.

Option 1: Proof through Country of Study

Proof of English proficiency is not required from those who have graduated from a high school or have completed two full-time semesters at an accredited post-secondary institution in the following countries:

English language proficiency waiver requests will be reviewed once your application and transcripts have been submitted.

Option 2: Proof through Academic Records

If English is not your first language or primary language of instruction, you can provide proof of English proficiency through your academic records. If you have any sub C grades in courses related to English proficiency, you will be required to submit results from an accepted proficiency test. All applicants are reviewed by members of the Admissions Committee. The Admissions Committee reserves the right to request additional materials.

Option 3: Proof through English Language Test Results

If English is not your first language or primary language of instruction and your academic records show English grades lower than a C in a US grading scale, you must provide the results from one of the exams listed below that meet the minimum listed scores:
