Teach-Out Agreement between UW-Superior and Northland College April 4, 2024



UW-Superior is prepared to serve as a teach-out institution for current undergraduate students at Northland College. As the nearest four-year university to Northland College, UW-Superior serves the same geographic region and has a shared commitment to intellectual growth and career preparation within a liberal arts tradition.

The terms of this agreement are as follows:

- Admission: Undergraduate admission to UW-Superior will be guaranteed for all Northland College students in good academic standing (cumulative GPA 2.0 or higher), and no application fees will be charged.
- Waived requirements: UW-Superior will waive minimum enrollment requirements and residency requirements for Northland College students.
- Transfer credits: 100% of undergraduate credits completed at Northland College, and 100% of undergraduate credits accepted as transfer credits from Northland College, will be accepted towards graduation requirements at UW-Superior.
- Tuition and fees: For each student transitioning to UW-Superior from Northland College, the applicable undergraduate tuition to complete required courses for graduation will be equal or lower than the published tuition at Northland College during the student's last year of enrollment, with any potential tuition increases in future years equivalent to any overall undergraduate tuition increase at UW-Superior. Lodging/meal costs and other fees beyond the tuition will be charged at the published undergraduate rates for UW-Superior. Each Northland College student will be provided complete information about tuition and fees and any other costs associated with completing their degrees at UW-Superior. The tuition agreement outlined above applies only to students that have previously matriculated at Northland College.
- Timeframe for degree completion: The pathway to graduation for each student transitioning to the UW-Superior will allow the student to complete their program in approximately the same timeframe that was possible at Northland College, or sooner, if the student maintains satisfactory progress and completes all requirements.
- Academic programs and course modality: UW-Superior provides academic programs in both online and oncampus (in-person) course modalities that correspond to Northland College majors. The programs available in this teach out agreement are listed in the tables below.

• **Student support:** UW-Superior prides itself on providing individualized support for all students. All members of the university who work directly with students, including members of UW-Superior faculty and instructional staff, advisors, admissions staff, financial aid staff, and members of the UW-Superior Transfer Center, will work to support each Northland College student as they consider teach-out options. This will include development of personalized degree planning. UW-Superior staff will be available for in-person and virtual meetings and will provide communications for Northland College regarding the transition process.

This agreement and its terms have been developed consistent with a provisional plan prepared by Northland College and approved by the Higher Learning Commission on March 18, 2024.
